2016 Winter 3-Day CERT Training

The Cities of Eugene and Springfield are offering a 3-day CERT training course for citizens within the Eugene-Springfield metro area. CERT trains citizens to be prepared to respond to emergency situations within their communities. Trained CERT volunteers are able to give critical support to first responders and provide immediate assistance to disaster victims. CERT volunteers also help with non-emergency projects that increase our community's preparedness.

CERT courses consist of a series of eight classes, which focus on preparedness, fire suppression, basic disaster medical skills, and light search and rescue operations. Each course concludes with a mock-disaster drill (to be held at a later date), which tests the participants' training. These courses are taught by volunteers and first responders who have completed a CERT Train-the-Trainer course and donate their time to help our community become better prepared and more resilient.
