The City of Eugene is offering a CERT training course for citizens in the Eugene-Springfield metro area. CERT trains citizens to be prepared to respond to emergency situations within their communities. Trained CERT volunteers are able to give critical support to first responders and provide immediate assistance to disaster victims. CERT volunteers also help with non-emergency projects that increase our community's preparedness.

CERT courses consist of a series of ten training segments, which focus on preparedness, fire suppression, basic disaster medical skills, light search and rescue operations, and more. Each course concludes with a mock-disaster drill which tests the participants' training. These courses are taught by volunteers and first responders who have completed a CERT Train-the-Trainer course and donate their time to help our community become better prepared and more resilient.
